

Oregon Educator Reciprocity Agreements. Candidates in all GFU educator preparation programs complete an accredited and TSPC-approved preparation program leading to an applicable and appropriate license issued by the [Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission](#). An educator licensed in Oregon or who completes a form for any of the states listed below verifying that the Oregon educator preparation program qualifies for licensure can be issued a license or certificate from each state. The following are 46 member states of the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC) Interstate Agreement who have signed reciprocity agreements with Oregon (unless noted). This meets the reporting requirements of the National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (NC-SARA)
